**P.G.Diploma in Ambedkar Studies**

**Objective of Course :**

The main objectives of this Diploma Course is to make Sanskrit students and others familiar with the ideas and perspectives of Dr. Ambedkar on Indian official language, Economics, Philosophy, Constitutional studies, Human Rights and social justice. In order to achieve these objectives the centre will also undertake research work along with conducting courses. It is hoped that the designed course will help students to develop appropriate methodologies to disseminate Dr. Ambedkar's ideas into practical proposition and policy instruments.

**Admission** – A batch will comprise of 50 students. Preference will be given to JRRSU students.

**Eligibility** – General public/any student at levels above graduation of formal education is eligible for admission. There is no entrance test.

**Duration** – 1 year (Maximum 2 years in case students have reason for not appearing in exams).

## **Programme Structure :**

The Diploma program on Ambedkar studies is a 600 marks program, consisting of six courses of 100 marks each. There are as follows courses :
